

Privacy Policy

In accordance with Federal Government Privacy Legislation of December 21 2001, this Practice has a Privacy Policy on handling patient information.

The practice collects information from you for the primary purpose of providing quality health care and aims to ensure that any information we hold is accurate, complete and up-to-date.

We require you to provide us with your personal details and medical information so we may properly assess and treat you.

The information you provide may also be used for administrative and billing purposes and for communication with your General Practitioner and/or Referrer associated with your treatment. Your additional consent will be obtained should the information be required for any other purpose.

You are entitled to withhold certain information and you have a right to access the information collected about you, except in certain circumstances where access might legitimately be withheld. Your consent is required to the handling of your personal information by the practice.
